Damage confirmed in District 7

Including surrounding areas, more than 300 people have died and others remain missing. About 250 households in District 7 alone were affected.

Economic losses are estimated at over 10 million Nepalese rupees (1 crore) and may go far higher. Rice paddies, crops and livestock were lost over a wide area.

Children were also reportedly swept away on their way to school.

[Urgent]

The father of Roshi Taman, a child supported by HFI, is missing inside the tunnel of the Upper Trishuli Hydroelectric Power Plant. 350 people are reported rescued, but it is unconfirmed whether he is among them. Please keep him in your thoughts.

The photo below shows the destroyed power house. Across the river is the town HFI regularly visits, where a four-story building was left in ruins.

Schools & Children

One private school was destroyed and one public school partially damaged. Some students were swept away while commuting.

Roads, bridges, and lifelines

About 3 km of main roads were severely damaged, the Trishuli River bridge washed away and water supply cut off.

Impact on agriculture and livestock

Rice paddies and crops were washed away over a wide area. Cattle, goats, water buffalo and about 2,500 poultry were lost.

Public and Power Facilities

The Trishuli hydro facility and dam were washed away. The District 7 office and a dormitory for the hearing impaired were damaged.

No major direct damage in upper District 7, but supply shortages are feared due to power outages and blocked roads.
