The children and families of Nwakot whom you have supported so far are being affected by this flood.

Status of deliveries from the local area

Due to large-scale flooding from the Tibetan border region in northern Nepal, severe damage has occurred in the Botekosi and Trishri river basins, especially in Raswa and Nwakot districts. Bridges, roads, homes, schools, communication facilities, and power generation facilities have suffered severe damage, and many people have been forced to evacuate from the area. This News is a heartbreaking blow for us at HFI. The children, families, school teachers, and community leaders who have walked alongside the Nwakot region for many years are now in the midst of this disaster. We have confirmed

the safety of the children and goat farmers, but the communication infrastructure is currently being restored, and we are awaiting the second report.
